UPCOMING CLUB EVENTS

6/5 Duvall Days Parade

This is a great parade for anyone who's ever thought of doing a parade. It's small enough to keep the stress down and we have enough veteran parade horses to help calm down the youngsters.

We will meet up at Taylor's Landing. Be there before 9:00, when they close off the streets. It's just north of the Woodinville-Duvall bridge, just north of the welding shop, down a dirt road with a public fishing sign.

Remember your red shirts, white hats, dark jeans and leather tack!

6/11-6/13 Joe Watts Canyon Campout

We haven't been to Joe Watts as a club for a couple years. The riding is pretty easy with a mix of roads, cross-country and some trails. Everyone who has been there has been telling me how pretty it is. But be prepared; there is no water, porta-potties or other amenities and not that many trees. It's also very tough to find a level place to park!

To get to Joe Watts:

Take I-90 to the Thorp exit (the fruit stand☺). As you come off the highway turn right onto Old Thorp Highway which runs parallel to I-90. Go RIGHT onto Old Cemetery Road and then turn left onto Joe Watt Canyon. Keep going through the gate and up the hill on the left.

6/19 Mt. Baldy Ride

We're going to add a new ride to our old standbys! Come check out Mt Baldy with us. It's down by Enumclaw. There are some hills but nothing too "interesting". Breast collars, front shoes and possibly cruppers are recommended.

To get there take Hwy 18 south to the Maple Valley exit. Take exit ramp toward Maple Valley (WA-169) / SE 231 St. and go left over freeway. Take a right onto Maple Valley Hwy (heading south) through Maple Valley and Black Diamond (WA State Route 169) to Enumclaw. At Enumclaw stay on 169 S. (see King County Fairgrounds sign). Turn left on SE 416th (see Stop N Shop store). Turn right on 284th Ave. S.E. Turn left on Hwy 410 / Roosevelt Ave. You will see a Crystal Mtn. sign as you head up 410. (approx 2 miles) Mt. Baldy trailer parking is just ahead. Hitching posts are visible from

road. There are 2 entrances in case you miss the first one

6/26-6/27 Darrington Rodeo

The Darrington is a great time. CVR helps park cars (on horseback) and rides in the grand entry. The rodeo itself is a blast, not too small and not too big. The rodeo starts at 1:00. CVR members are invited to camp onsite; we can show up on Friday. The campground has water and some nice trails. We'll have a potluck on Saturday evening.

Take Hwy 9 to hwy 530. The Rodeo grounds are on the left.
