TRAP

Cherry Valley Rides has an awards program called TRAP (Trail Riders Award Program). Members log their riding hours on a form for the year and that form is turned into the chairperson before the annual CVR Christmas party. At the party award pins are handed out for 50, 100, 250, 500 and 1000 hours. Hours are added to each other each year. Hours spent in arenas do not count, these hours need to be spent on the trail. Time starts from when you swing your leg into the saddle until you dismount at the end of the ride. The chairperson then sends these forms to the King and Snohomish County Parks and Recreation Departments to show which trails are being used by horseback riders and what condition those trails are in. This is done in hopes of keeping trails open by showing that they are being used and appreciated by trailriders. It's also a fun way to see how many hours you spend in the saddle. Don't forget, all Cherry Valley rides count for double hours.

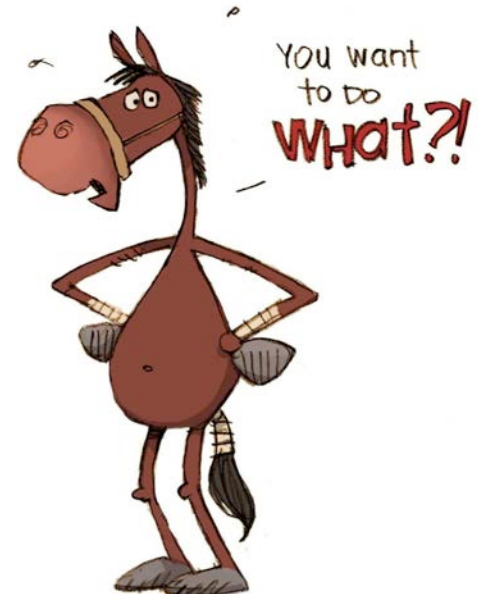
